

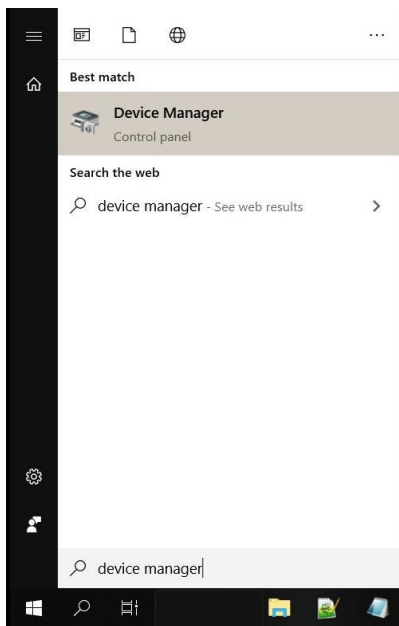


How to install the ANT USB Adapter drivers on Windows

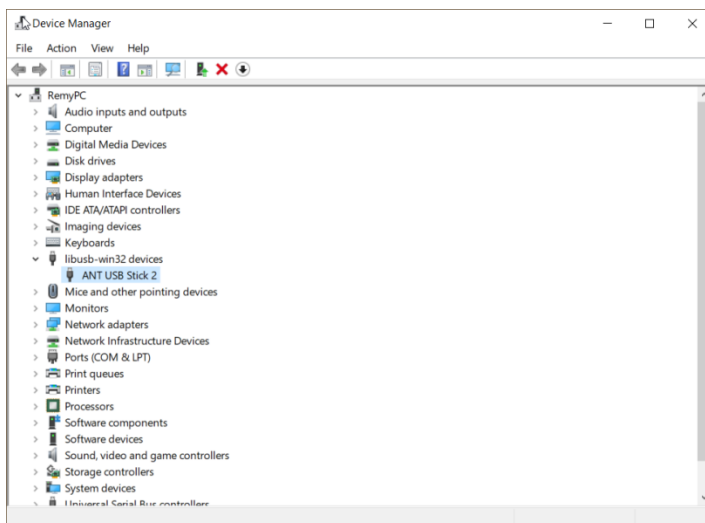
Usually when you plug in the ANT Adapter, it should automatically work. It could happen though that it does not automatically install properly on Windows 10.

Please only install according to these instructions, and do not try to install it by clicking on the included applications with the .exe extension.

1. First open “Device Manager”



2. Go to the USB driver, it is most likely called “libusb-win32 devices”, and has an USB Icon.

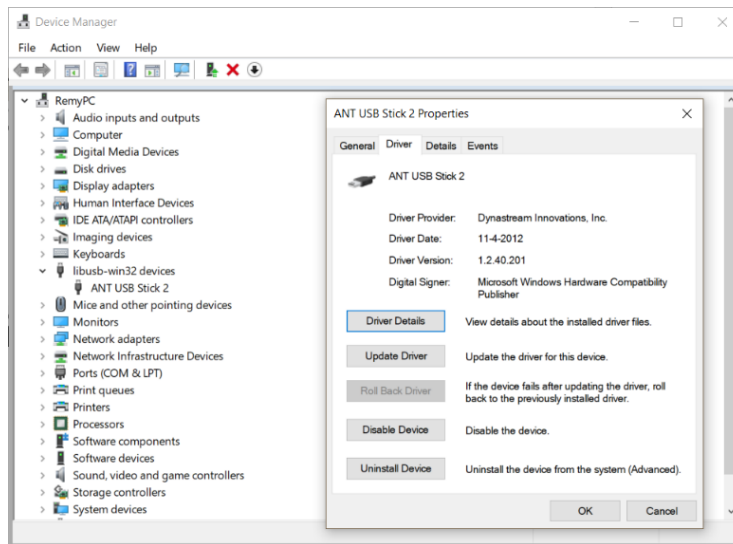




3. Right click on the device called “ANT USB-m Device”

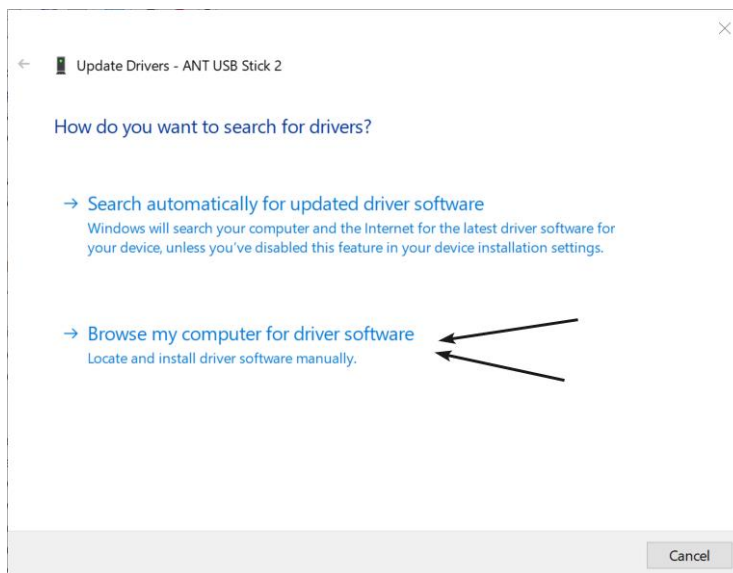
If no such device is in the list and you are certain you have plugged the ANT Adapter in properly, and do see an “unknown device” right click on that.

4. Click on “properties”, and go to the driver tab.



5. Click on “Update driver”

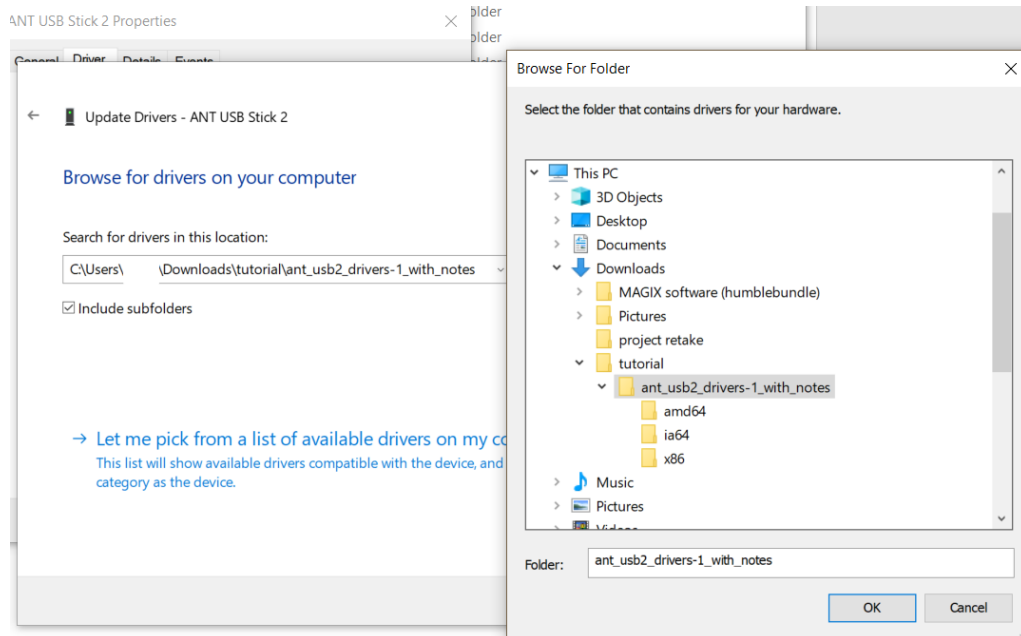
6. Select “Browse my computer for driver software”





7. Go to the folder where you placed the folder you downloaded from www.futurumshop.nl/xand/downloads

8. Select the folder “ant_usb2_drivers-1_with_notes”



9. Click on “OK”

10. The computer will now install the correct driver. There is a 32bit and 64 bit version of the driver in the folder.

After the computer indicates it has installed the latest driver, the folder “ant_usb2_drivers-1_with_notes” can be deleted safely.

11. **IMPORTANT:** Restart your computer for the driver installation to complete.

12. If the issue persists after restarting your computer, please go back to step 5, and select “Search automatically for updated driver software” instead.
